Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to inform you that our school will once again be taking part in the **Young Voices 2027** concert – the largest children's choir concert in the world! <https://youngvoices.co.uk/> This unforgettable event brings together thousands of children from across the country to sing as one incredible choir in some of the UK's biggest arenas. It's a truly inspiring experience that your child will remember for years to come.

Why sign up?

Taking part in Young Voices provides children with:

- A chance to perform live in a professional arena
- Exposure to a wide variety of musical styles
- A boost in confidence and teamwork skills
- An opportunity to be part of a once-in-a-lifetime musical event

What you need to know:

- **Commitment:** With so many songs to learn, we are starting choir club even earlier this year. Children must attend choir club after school **every Thursday**. Children are not able to have words on the day of the concert so they need to have learnt them off by heart to fully take part.
- **Date of concert:** Friday 15th January 2027 (please note: children will not arrive back at school until approximately 10.30pm).
- **Venue:** BP Pulse Birmingham (previously the NEC). Children will travel by coach.
- **Rehearsals:** After school every Thursday in the school hall.
- **Cost:** We will request payment in the new academic year to cover the transport costs (approx. £10).
- **Tickets and T-Shirts** (optional) – there are Young Voices branded t-shirts available to buy, and tickets available for parents to watch the evening show. These are bookable via the Young Voices portal (information will be sent out at a later date) but they are not essential and children can still attend the event without branded t-shirts (plain white can be worn instead) or spectators.
